The Net Time will be designated. So take it easy at the start.

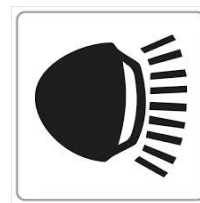
The road traffic regulations are valid!

In case of nonobservance of the road traffic regulation, a disqualification will be carried out. In particular on...

- No light on the bike in the Tunnel
- Overtaking the leading vehicle
- Disobey the right driving order
- Jumping a red light
- Unadapted speed
- Improperly behaviour

A helmet is required!

Your number has to be on the handlebar and your back!



Light requirement!

LIGHT ON: This Slogan also applies to bikers who take part on a bike race on non barred streets. This rule is mainly focused on tunnels with no or bad lighting.

The light requirement gives the rider a better protection. That means for the rider, to bring on light in the front, as well in the back of the bike to be prepared for these situations.

The observation of these rules will be checked by the police. Is a biker without proper lighting on a track with tunnels, will be disqualified.

Track from Flexenpass till Klösterle is neutralized

Section-Control: At least 13 minutes



Due to clean-up renovations, the Arlberg-Tunnel is closed at the Highlander weekend and this means a high traffic volume at the Arlberg-Peak.

Track Flexenpass till Kloesterle is neutralized

From the above described reasons, we have decided, the track from Flexenpass till Klösterle to neutralize. This means the net-time will be stopped after the refreshment-checkpoint at Flexenpass and will be started again in Klösterle after passing of a time-loop. So there is no need to hurry on this section of the track, because...



Section-Control

In this section a minimum time of 13 minutes is required, which is oriented on the maximum speed limit on this section. If you fall below this minimum time, you will be disqualified.



Timekeeping-Chip

Please wear the chip as shown in the picture. So the timekeeping is guaranteed.

Please hand the Chip at the medal-expand in the refreshment-village (schoolyard) after you crossed the finish-line. There you also get your chip-deposit (EUR 20,-) back.
